Using the Epson Workforce 645: Basic Operations

Printing a Document

Printing a document on the Workforce 645 is straightforward:

Paper Handling Options

The Workforce 645 supports a range of paper types and sizes. Use the printer's **Paper Tray Settings** to configure:

- Tray capacity (up to 250 sheets).
- Paper type (plain, cardstock, envelopes).
- Feed direction (top or bottom).

Properly setting these options reduces paper jams and improves print quality.

Security Features

For businesses that handle sensitive data, the Workforce 645 includes several security options:

Low Toner Warning

When the toner level drops below 10%, the printer displays a low toner warning. To address this:

1. Purchase a replacement toner cartridge from a reputable supplier.
2. Open the toner compartment and remove the old cartridge.
3. Insert the new cartridge and close the compartment.
4. Reset the toner counter via the printer's maintenance menu.

Regularly monitoring toner levels can prevent unexpected downtime.

Maintaining Your Epson Workforce 645

Regular Cleaning

Keep the printer's interior clean to ensure optimal performance:

- Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth.
- Use a soft brush to clean the paper feed rollers.
- Replace any worn or damaged components promptly.

Follow Epson's cleaning guidelines found in the **Maintenance** section of the web interface.

Firmware Updates

Firmware updates can improve functionality and fix bugs. To update:

2. Use the Print option to send the entire file to the printer.
