7. Install the new filter, tightening to 10 ft lb.
8. Fill with 15.5 quarts of 0W 20 oil.
9. Check for leaks and reset the oil change indicator.

Step 4: Verify and Document

After the job, use the manual's troubleshooting section on page 152 to check for any potential issues. Record the maintenance date and mileage in a service log for future reference.
